Welcome- Meeting led by Andrew Jones

Principal Update: Lots to update, make sure people are getting her email newsletters as some people weren't getting them, is email the best way to communicate? Twitter? Facebook or blog post on website.

- -ELA MCAS wrapped up and went smooth, first time in 2 years we had 2 sessions. Math MCAS in May and 5th grade does Science/tech as well.
- -Field trips coming up, Wingmasters came in the 3rd grade, Polar Pride, 6th grade graduation and the Carnival.
- -Staffing updates-coming out in newsletter but hired Alison Lahey as Assistant Principal for next year, 20 years' experience, is currently, Special Ed Coordinator was at Conant and MCT, 18 years at MCT, thrilled to have her in this new role. Currently hiring certified library and media specialist, currently only an assistant role. Adding a 3rd Connections teacher in the LC for next year as 34 students and 2 educators, need more staffing. We are hiring a BCBA for Gates/Conant and a School Psychologist in process. Sabrina Collins moving to 6thgrade next year.
- -3/23 was a school council meeting, notes Val will post on the website, working on school improvement plan and the purpose of the committee is to be collaborative. Currently 2 parents, 2 teachers and Val and hoping to expand to more people. Next meeting 4/27 and want to recruit more interest and following Peter Lights goal of feedback and action steps of 1)SEL 2) Cultural responsive practices 3) multi-tiered system of support
- -Budget update, change in approach of teaching assistant model to educational instructional specialists/coaches(literacy, math, stem), working in small groups for teachers, what will that look like. Master



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schedule next year MTSS model geared towards specialists ELA, intervention during WIN block so specialist is available per grade. Implementation on co-teaching model, what does that look like? What can the PTO do to help, can parents fill the void? Fall PTO meeting agenda item, what can parents do to volunteer, make copies, put materials together? We will loose 72 hours a week 1st to 6th of assistant hours at Conant, across district policy change. We need to think creatively on how to use admin assistants, parents donate hours to help
